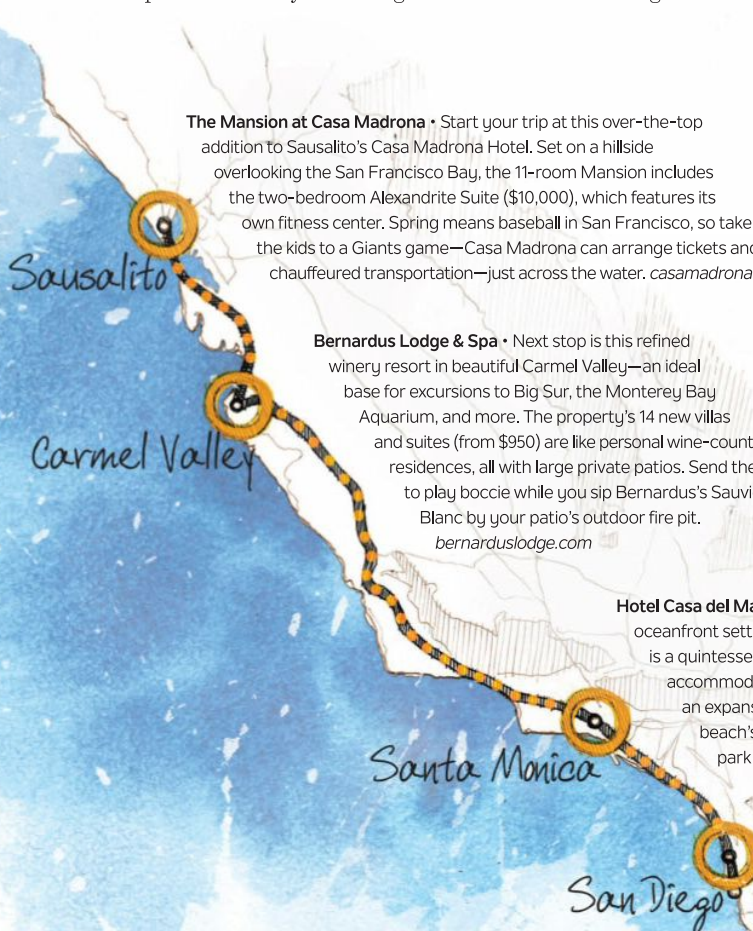
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High-Speed Spring Break

A Golden State road trip to keep every member of the family smiling.

California is calling family travelers this spring, with spacious new villas and suites cropping up at some of the state's finest hotels and resorts. For a compelling coastal road trip with the kids, *Robb Report* suggests a family-friendly Ferrari—the four-seat, 690 hp GTC4Lusso—and an action-packed itinerary stretching from Sausalito to San Diego. —BRUCE WALLIN



The Mansion at Casa Madrona • Start your trip at this over-the-top addition to Sausalito's Casa Madrona Hotel. Set on a hillside overlooking the San Francisco Bay, the 11-room Mansion includes the two-bedroom Alexandrite Suite (\$10,000), which features its own fitness center. Spring means baseball in San Francisco, so take the kids to a Giants game—Casa Madrona can arrange tickets and chauffeured transportation—just across the water. casamadrona.com

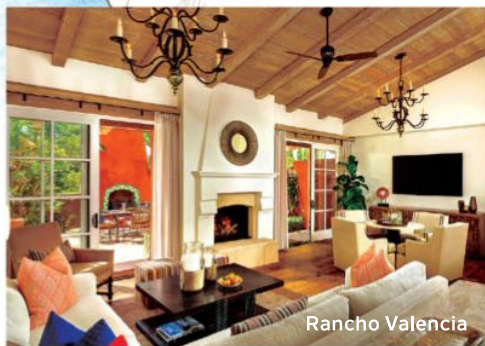
Bernardus Lodge & Spa • Next stop is this refined winery resort in beautiful Carmel Valley—an ideal base for excursions to Big Sur, the Monterey Bay Aquarium, and more. The property's 14 new villas and suites (from \$950) are like personal wine-country residences, all with large private patios. Send the kids to play bocce while you sip Bernardus's Sauvignon Blanc by your patio's outdoor fire pit. bernarduslodge.com

Hotel Casa del Mar • With its contemporary nautical decor and oceanfront setting, this Santa Monica hotel's Presidential Suite (\$6,500) is a quintessential California retreat. The recently renovated accommodation is spacious enough for six, featuring two bedrooms and an expansive living and dining area—all with beach views. Stroll down the beach's boardwalk to the fun-for-all-ages carousel and amusement park at the Santa Monica Pier. hotelcasadelmar.com

Rancho Valencia • Wrap up your journey in San Diego's sun-drenched hills in one of Rancho Valencia's newly renovated two- and three-bedroom homes (from \$1,992). Each has a kitchen and hot tub, though the villa-guest-only club pool is best for a boisterous bunch, fully stocked with noodles and diving toys. The resort's half-day Junior Ranchers program puts a sophisticated spin on children's camp, with taco-making sessions, tennis lessons, yoga, and more. ranchovalencia.com
